

I started in Cardigans in 1952 via my parents Willowbeach kennel prefix. The first champion I handled to his title was Ch Wildfowl of Willowbeach born in 1958 who also became my first of twenty two national best in show winners at the U.K Cardigan annual national specialty shows. The Joseter prefix was registered with the Kennel Club in the 1960s when I started my own kennel, and today the name Joseter can be found in pedigrees around the world. My judging career started in 1959 with a small match meeting since when I have judged Cardigans national specialties both home and around the world since 1975. I judged Cardigans twice and Boston Terriers at Crufts and have also judged Boston Terrier national specialties at home and overseas.

From my early days in the breed many have invested time sharing knowledge and time with me and I hope today they look down and feel I have lived up to expectations. Today I try to share this with others, by my example as a breeder, exhibitor, handler and judge, trusting that this may help our wonderful breed for the next generation.

Seventy one years on. I personally feel proud of the Joseter and my personal achievements (which can all be viewed on the Joseter web site) within the breed I must leave to others to decide if these have contributed to the vast improvements today seen in the breed. Today I remain totally committed to our wonderful breed and trust that my appraisal of exhibits retain extra value whether one wins or not.
